"A Week in the Life of an ICA" (Fall 2014)
Time Breakdown of responsibilities & duties

DUTY/RESPONSIBILITY	Time: hrs/wk on average
Training & Education Engaged Learning Opportunities ("TEELO") sessions: Every Wednesday evening (6:15 – 8:30pm; 8:30-9:15 optional "social" time). These take place in each Neighborhood (for this 2014-15, Brody, North & Rivertrail Neighborhoods will combine for TEELOs). Once a month usually the last Wednesday of each month, there is a COMBINED TEELO where all ICAs will meet together in one location.	3 hrs
Preparing for TEELO During TEELOs, there is a "STUDY" portion of the session that will require some academic reading and/or reviewing of materials provided to ICAs the week before. ICAs are expected to make the time to thoroughly read/review these materials to prepare for engaging with the content of the material during TEELOs.	1-2 hrs
Weekly Student Visitations & Interactions ICAs are required to do 4-6 hrs/week of "knocking on doors" of 1 st year residents, with priority given to Spartan Success Scholars, on different floors and sometimes an entire building (depending on which hall they reside). During these time periods, ICAs "check in" and find out about the welfare of residents. <i>This contrasts to Ras whose residents are in close proximity to their rooms on a particular floor.</i>	4-6 hrs
Engaged Learning Opportunities (depending on week, ICAs may have 1-2 of these events to attend) All ICA are required to attend a minimum of 2 MRULE Roundtable Discussions (RTD) each month, a service activity and a social activity.	2-3 hrs
ELO planning /reflection ELO Planning – CSC facilitators will be required to plan one Service activity and one social activity associated with the neighborhood each month and to reflect on these activities.	1-2 hrs
RTD facilitators will be required to plan 2 RTD meetings per month and to reflect on these meetings	
Residence Education Staff & Neighborhood meetings (depending on week, ICA will have at one of these meetings) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Hall All-staff meeting (once a month) * Neighborhood meeting (once a month) 	1hrs
MAPWORKS Documentation & Weekly Reports <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Aides are required to document their weekly interactions with Student Success Initiative students through the MAPWORKS system. They are also required to document their other interactions with students, along with other activities they have participated in during the week that relate to the Aide job through the CCAT Aide's Google Docs system. 	2-4 hrs
One-on-ones with Direct Supervisors– Monthly meeting with Neighborhood Supervisor	1 hrs
Staff responsibilities within floor/hall <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Just like Ras, Aides "live where they work," and therefore, they are often the front-line people to assist residents when questions and concerns arise, when residents need help in resolving an issue, or when an incident must be addressed 	2 hrs
